

My Total Rewards: Paid Time Off (PTO) Accruals

The PTO accrual levels and maximums are outlined below. Employees working less than full time earn prorated PTO based upon hours paid. Employees authorized 48-59 hours per pay period accrue at 75 percent of the full-time accrual rate.
