

## M HEALTH FAIRVIEW ST JOHN'S HOSPITAL PGY1 Pharmacy Residency



### Program Overview

The Pharmacy Residency Program (PGY1) at M Health Fairview St. John's Hospital in Maplewood, MN is a 12-month program consisting of core and elective learning experiences that are tailored to the resident's interests.

M Health Fairview St. John's Hospital is a 184-bed community hospital serving a diverse population in the northeast metro area. The M Health Fairview St. John's PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Program offers the resident an opportunity to work collaboratively with other health care providers and leaders to develop skills in patient-centered care, practice management, and leadership. The St. John's resident learning experience includes: instruction in central and decentralized pharmacist roles, participation in multidisciplinary care rounds, staffing, educational presentations, and completion of a major residency project. The St. John's residency program is committed to developing a resident with a firm understanding of the pharmacist's role in the medication management system and how this role spans the entire continuum of patient care.

### PGY1 Residency Program Purpose

To build upon the Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and outcomes to develop community-based pharmacist practitioners with diverse patient care, leadership, and education skills who are eligible to pursue advanced training opportunities including postgraduate year two (PGY2) residencies and professional certifications.

### Required Learning Experiences

- Orientation (2 weeks)
- Training (6 weeks)
- Staffing (11 months)
- Professional Development & Pharmacy Practice Contributions (11 months)
- Internal Medicine (6 weeks)
- Critical Care (7 weeks)
- Cardiology (5 weeks)
- Infectious Disease (4 weeks)
- Leadership & Practice Management (4 weeks)
- Medication Use Evaluation (6 months)
- Practice-Related Research Project (12 months)

This schedule allows for three elective learning experiences.

- Present at Fairview Pharmacy Grand Rounds
